

Declaration of RoHS Compliance

This document shall serve as formal declaration that products, produced by Volburg Ltd., are in compliance with:

1. Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (recast)
2. Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of January 27 2003 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

RoHS 2 Substances and Limits

The substances currently regulated by the RoHS 2 Directive are listed below:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr(VI))
- Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) flame retardants
- Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants (including Deca-BDE)

The maximum allowable concentration is 0.1% by weight in homogeneous material. For Cadmium, the maximum allowable concentration is 0.01% by weight in homogeneous material.

Compliance is evidenced by declarations from our Suppliers, assuring that any potential trace levels of the above listed substances are below the maximum levels set, or are exempt due to their application.

To the best of our knowledge, Volburg Ltd. products are not intentionally manufactured or formulated with substances exceeding the above threshold except as noted below.

In reference to the directives described above, Volburg Ltd. certifies that its product labeled as RoHS and RoHS-2 are compliant to both Directives. Product previously issued with a certification and labeled as RoHS 2002/95/EC compliant is also compliant to RoHS-2 2011/65/EU. No warranty or liability of indemnification is expressed or implied with this information.
